Located on the Eastern bench of Dry Creek Valley, the 22-acre Bushnell Vineyard has been in the Pedroncelli family for 80 years. Winery founder Giovanni purchased the property in 1943. Daughter Margaret and husband Al Pedroni tended the Zinfandel and Petite Sirah vineyard for 40 years. Their daughter Carol Bushnell now farms it maintaining the eight-decade family connection with this vineyard. Winemaker Montserrat Reece values the singular Bushnell Vineyard spice and it shows beautifully.

BLOCK 10 2022 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

Established in the early 1900s, the Home Ranch Vineyard is found on the eastern hillsides of Dry Creek Valley. The 50-acre vineyard surrounds the winery and is the site of Block 10, situated on a bench. Winemaker Montserrat Reece chose this block to showcase the unique quality of the grape as grown on this site with soil, farming, and climate all coming into play. This deep and full-flavored wine with rounded tannins is tamed by the terroir eliciting a unique expression of Cabernet Sauvignon.

COURAGE 2022 ZINFANDEL

Dave Faloni is from a three-generation grape-growing family. The vineyard is located on the western side of Dry Creek along the valley floor. While most Zinfandel is traditionally head-pruned, Dave has trained his vines on a trellis. He knows every quirk of the soil and every vine. Winemaker Montserrat Reece chose the Faloni vineyard because of its unique lush fruit character. She teases out the rich berry and spice and compares the style to a full-flavored Tempranillo, recalling the wines of Spain, her homeland.

WISDOM 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

The land was purchased by Jim and John Pedroncelli in 1965 and is located on the west side of Dry Creek Valley. Planted to Cabernet Sauvignon the same year, Pedroncelli was the first winery to establish the variety here. The vineyard was replanted in 2002 with Clone 4, also known as the Mendoza Clone. It produces smaller, more compact bunches and shows deeper color and concentration. We have nearly 60 years of growing Cabernet in this singular microclimate, showcasing the deeply flavored fruit.
